### EVERY LESSON COUNTS - Introducing Class Dojos!

We want every child to get the best educational start in life that we can give them. This means being **here every day, here on time**. That way, they don't miss a bit of their learning, there are no gaps in their knowledge and it gives them the best start.

To support this, we are introducing a new strategy where children and classes earn special points - called Class Dojos - every time they are here and on time. These points lead to rewards: Fab Fridays, where children can choose activities for a period. More points means more free choice time minutes. . The class with the
